Liquor Control Act 1988 HOTEL RESTRICTED LICENCE

The licensee named above is authorised to sell liquor at the licensed premises described above, in accordance with the Liquor Control Act 1988 ("the Act"). The licensee must comply with all requirements and conditions imposed by the Act, any conditions or authorisations published by notice under s 31 of the Act, and any conditions or requirements set out below. The license continues in force until surrendered or cancelled under the Act.

TRADING HOURS

Issue No: 1.0

The permitted trading hours are those prescribed in s 98 of the Act for a hotel licence.

TRADING CONDITIONS

- 1. The licensee is authorised to sell and supply liquor in accordance with the provisions of s 41 of the Act as it relates to a hotel restricted licence.
- 2. The sale and supply of packaged liquor for consumption off the licensed premises to persons other than lodgers, is prohibited.
- 3. The Licensee must not sell or supply more than four standard drinks per person per day, regardless of whether the liquor is sold:
 - (a) for consumption on the licensed premises; or
 - (b) as packaged liquor for consumption in the purchaser's accommodation; or
 - (c) a combination of both (a) and (b).
- 4. Drink options that contain low alcohol liquor content as well as a range of non-alcoholic drink options must be available during trading hours.
- 5. The licensee shall not promote, advertise or employ incentives which encourage the excessive consumption of liquor by virtue of their 'emotive' titles such as (but not exclusive to) 'laybacks', 'slammers', 'jelly-shots', 'test tubes' and 'blasters'.

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6. Food must be available during all trading hours.

7. The following licensed areas have a maximum occupancy of:

(a) Diner and Cafeteria:304 persons(b) Cinema/theatre/meeting room:69 persons(c) Tavern and Beer Garden:815 persons

- 8. Seating must be provided for at least 50% of the maximum number of persons permitted in the following areas:
 - (a) Diner and Cafeteria; and
 - (b) Tavern and Beer Garden
- A CCTV video surveillance system must be in place and operational. The system must comply
 with the minimum requirements identified and be maintained in accordance with the Director's
 Safety and Security at Licensed Premises policy.

ENTERTAINMENT CONDITION

- 1. A person resorting to, or on the premises, including the licensee or manager, or an employee or agent of the licensee or manager, shall not:
 - (a) be immodestly or indecently dressed on the licensed premises, and/or
 - (b) take part in, undertake or perform any activity or entertainment on the licensed premises in a lewd or indecent manner.
- 2. The licensee or manager, or an employee or agent of the licensee or manager, is prohibited from:
 - (a) exhibiting or showing, or causing, suffering or permitting to be exhibited or shown, on the licensed premises any "R 18+", "X 18+" or "RC" classified film or computer game or "Category 1 – Restricted" or "Category 2 – Restricted" publication, or extract therefrom; or
 - (b) causing, suffering or permitting any person employed, engaged or otherwise contracted to undertake any activity or perform any entertainment on the licensed premises to be immodestly or indecently dressed on the licensed premises; or
 - (c) causing, suffering or permitting any person to take part in, undertake or perform any activity or entertainment on the licensed premises in a lewd or indecent manner.
- 3. In this condition "licensed premises" includes any premises, place or area:
 - (a) which is appurtenant to the licensed premises; or
 - (b) in respect of which an extended trading permit granted to the licensee is for the time being in force,

but does not include any part of the premises which is reserved for the private use of the licensee, manager or employees of the licensee and to which the public does not have access.

COMPLIANCE WITH HARM MINIMISATION POLICY

The licensee has lodged a copy of the House Management Policy, Code of Conduct and Management Plan developed for these premises in accordance with the Harm Minimisation Policy. These documents must be retained on the licensed premises and produced to any Authorised Officer if required.

This licence takes effect from 28 May 2024.
